

TYPES OF FIRE EXTINGUISHERS AND HAZARD CHART

Please use our Hazard Chart to determine which type or types of **fire extinguishers** are suitable for your needs. The chart details each type of fire extinguisher and its intended purpose. A tick indicates that this type of extinguisher is suitable for hazard listed, a cross indicates this fire extinguisher type cannot be used for the hazard listed. You may require a combination of fire extinguishers depending on the types of hazard that may arise. Ideally you will have completed a full hazard assessment to determine any hazard possibilities, however if you aren't certain then feel free to **contact** one of our experts.
